Cities, rural water districts, mobile home parks and many other types of water and wastewater systems are responsible for staffing those systems with certified operators. Operators are required to obtain training in order to gain and maintain certification. All systems must be under the direction of at least one supervising operator who is certified.

KRWA's mission is: *To provide leadership, education, and technical assistance to public water and wastewater utilities to enhance the public health and to sustain Kansas' communities.*

KRWA is proud of its long history of providing training for both water and wastewater systems. Since 1976, KRWA has facilitated, sponsored or conducted

more than 2,230 sessions. Since that first session on April 3, 1976 when 101 people from 48 systems attended a water system training seminar in Iola, KRWA's history of providing training remains unmatched in Kansas.
