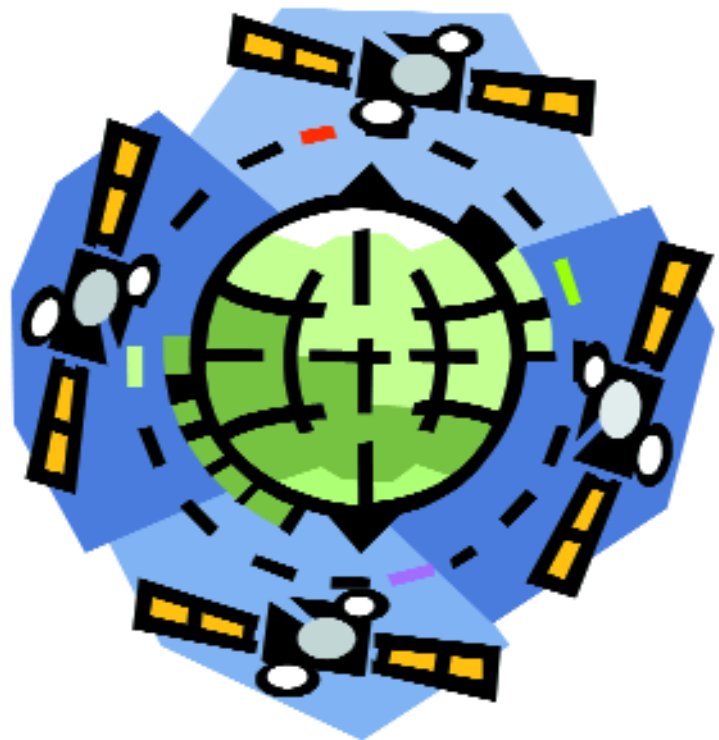

New GIS/GPS training coming from KRWA ...
