

## Kansas Rural Water Association creates fund for City of Greensburg, KS

The Kansas Rural Water Association has created a fund so that Association members in Kansas and cities and water systems across the U.S. can provide financial assistance to the city government of the City of Greensburg, Kansas. Greensburg was devastated by an EF-5 tornado at 9:45 p.m., Friday, May 4, 2007. The southwest Kansas city of 1600 was leveled. There are 10 deaths.

Many cities and water districts in Kansas and other states have inquired for ways to donate materials or labor services or to make contributions to help the city re-establish services.

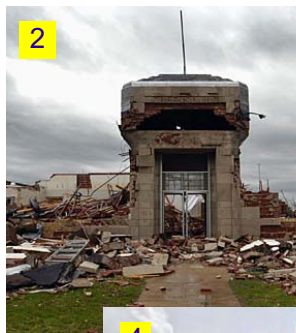
Kansas Rural Water has established the Greensburg Fund to provide assistance to the city government of Greensburg, KS.
